4. <u>TEST PROCEDURE</u>

<u>Note</u> Unless stated otherwise the temperature of the test fluid shall be $20 \pm 10^{\circ}$ C

4.1 Tests applicable to the following fittings:-

ICE MAKING MACHINES

(A) ICE MAKING MACHINES

TEST METHOD

Connect the appliance to a suitable electrical and water supply. Place a container at the water drain of the machine if applicable. In accordance with the manufacturers instructions, operate the appliance through one complete cycle. Operate the appliance through one complete cycle and collect the ice and waste water, where applicable. Empty the ice storage bin of ice and any water collected in the storage bin (melted ice) B. Ascertain amount of ice/water in the storage bin (KG). Ascertain amount of water discharged to drain (KG).

Weigh the amount of waste water - (A). $\frac{B}{A+B}$ x 100% = Measured volume of water converted into ice.

Weigh the amount of ice made - (B).

5. <u>ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA</u>

At least 33% of the measured volume of water used by the appliance during one cycle of operation shall be converted into ice.
